



PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS BREAST SURGERY

**Items to be picked up prior to surgery (these are over the counter)-
Gauze Pads (*for breast lift/reduction surgery only*)**

1. Please make us aware of all medications you are taking. Begin taking your VitaMedica supplements provided to you-

Clinical Support- two weeks prior to surgery and two weeks after.

Bromelain- three days prior to surgery and continue for 7 days

2. Do not take aspirin or aspirin containing products two weeks prior or two weeks after surgery as it may cause excessive bleeding. Tylenol is a good medication to take for any aches or pains before your surgery.

3. Diet medications are to be discontinued four weeks prior to surgery. Please make us aware of all medications you are taking.

4. If you develop a cold or any other illness prior to the date of your surgery, please notify us.

5. Smoking will affect the way you heal. It is critical that you DO NOT SMOKE AND AVOID PLACES WHERE PEOPLE SMOKE FOR AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE AND A MINIMUM OF ONE MONTH AFTER YOUR SURGERY. NOTIFY US IMMEDIATELY IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO AVOID CIGARETTES.

6. The Evening Before Your Surgery- Make sure that you have any prescriptions your surgeon has prescribed for you filled and available to you immediately after your surgery. Bring them with you to the surgery center.

7. DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT IF YOUR SURGERY IS SCHEDULED BEFORE NOON.

8. The Morning of Your Surgery- DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING IF YOUR SURGERY IS SCHEDULED BEFORE NOON. If your surgery is after noon, be sure that nothing is consumed 8 hours before your surgery. Take any prescribed medications with a sip of water. Do not chew gum.

9. Do not apply body lotion or powder to any part of your body.

10. Do not wear any makeup.

11. Do not wear contact lenses, panty hose, pull over tops or jewelry (includes all piercings) to the surgery center. Dress in loose comfortable clothes, button-up tops are best. Wear slip on shoes. If you wear dentures or contacts, please bring a container.

12. If you are having surgery on an outpatient basis, the person taking you to the surgery center will be required to stay and listen to all instructions. You will not be allowed to drive yourself from the surgery center. If you are having surgery on an inpatient basis, it is mandatory that a responsible adult spend the night and take you home.
